JOB DESCRIPTION

Firefighters perform rescue and firefighting operations to include fires, vehicle accidents, and natural disasters.

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

- Drives fire trucks and other emergency vehicles to emergencies.
- Puts out fires using hoses and pumps.
- Finds and rescues victims in burning buildings or in other emergencies.
- Provides public education on fire safety.
- Prepares written reports on fire or emergency incidents.
- Cleans and maintains equipment.
- Conducts drills and training in fire fighting techniques.
- Treats victims' injuries with emergency medical services.





HOW TO LAND YOUR 1ST JOB

- Must fulfill requirements for your testing department.
- Pass written entry exams and being able to pass physical agility tests.
- Interviews (Ex: Board Polygraph, Fire Chief's interview)



GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- Age 18 to 35 at the time of the entrance examination.
- Have a Class B Driver's License within one year of employment.
- Comply with all applicable **Civil Service Requirements** and Regulations.
- Permanent residence within a 40 minute response time to the city limits of the department.
- Proof of valid driver's license with an acceptable driving record.



- If your high school has an EMS/ EMT program, take it.
- Volunteer at a local fire station.
- Talk to your local firefighter to see if it is something you would like.

High school diploma or GED EMT/EMS Training and certification.

Certificates, Associates degrees and Bachelor's degree in Fire Science

→ Pass the state fire suppression exam.
